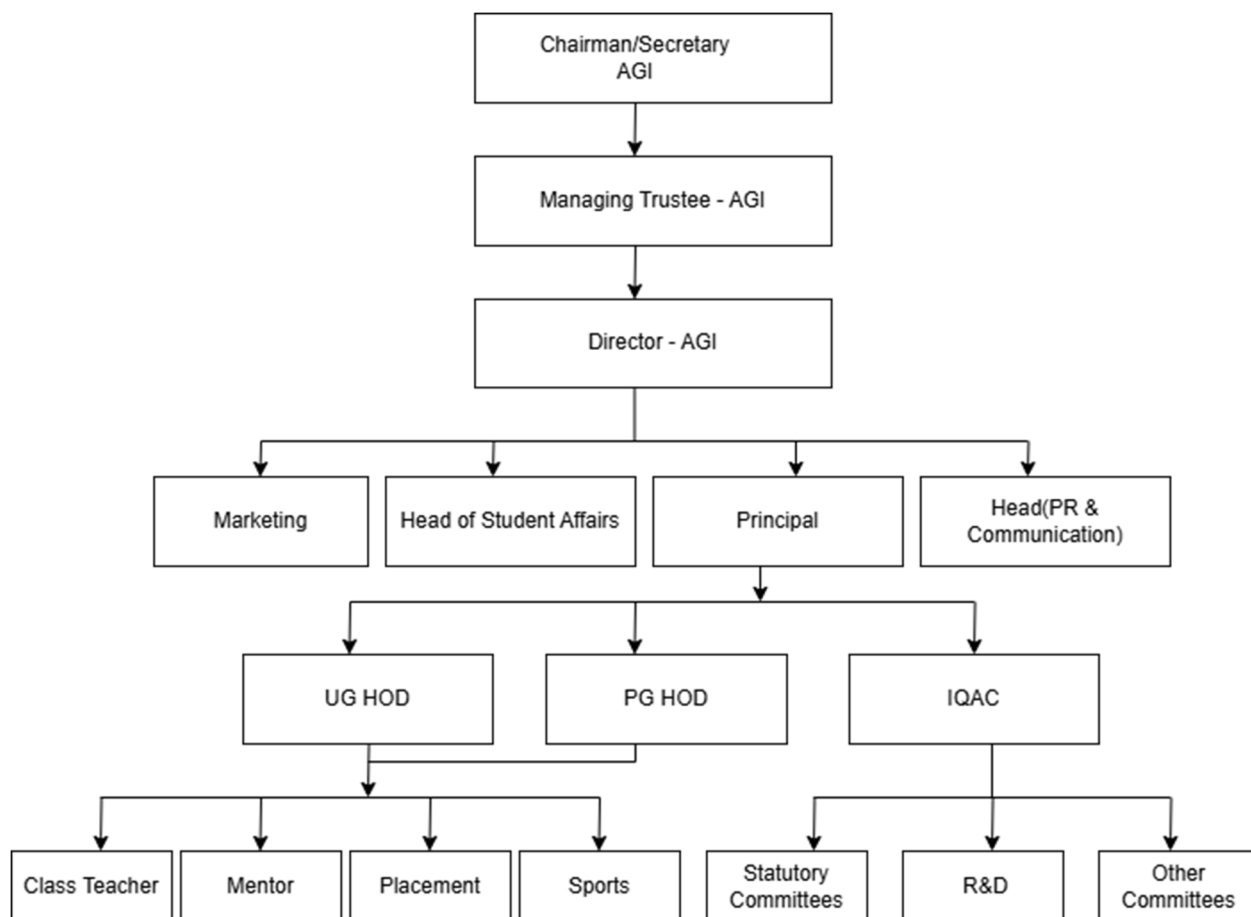

II. Grievance Redressal Mechanism for faculty, staff, and students

The College has constituted an Internal Complaints Committee (ICC), chaired by a senior woman faculty member. At the beginning of each semester, students and staff are oriented about the grievance redressal mechanism.

Students, faculty, and staff may submit academic or non-academic grievances through the online grievance/suggestion box.

Upon receipt of a complaint, the ICC is notified and initiates the due process, ensuring strict confidentiality and anonymity of the complainant.

The matter is reviewed through structured deliberations, and appropriate action is taken until a fair and feasible resolution is achieved.

III. Establishment of Anti-Ragging Committee

In accordance with the directives of the Supreme Court of India, the All-India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), and the Karnataka Education Act, 1983, ragging is recognized as a serious criminal offence.

Arihant Institute of Commerce and Management strictly adheres to the provisions of law and recognises that ragging in any form is a criminal offence. It is strictly prohibited both within and outside the Institute

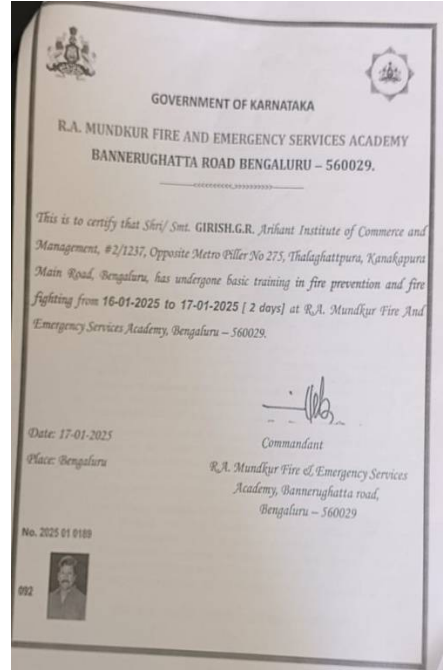
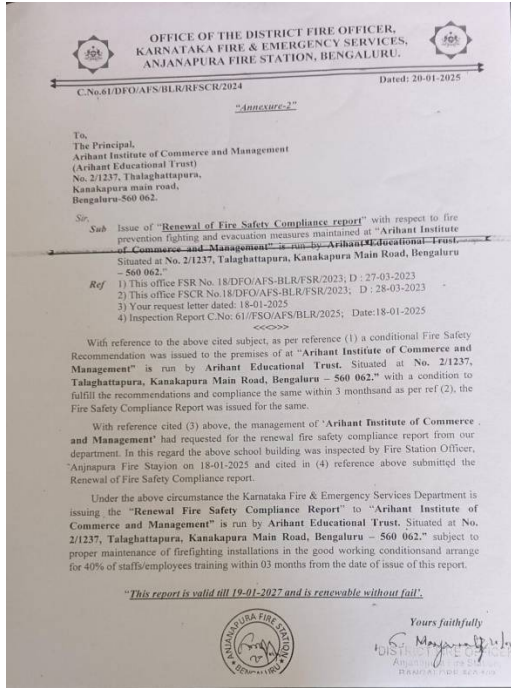
