Gatekeeper Training for Educators

Held at Arihant Institute



24th January 2025, Arihant Institute of Commerce and Management, in association with NIMHANS, organized a training program on "Gatekeeper Training for Educators." The program aimed to enhance educators' understanding of mental health and equip them with the skills to identify early signs of psychological distress in students.

The session was conducted by Dr. Manjula M and Dr. Tanvi, under the guidance of Dr. Seema Mehrotra from the Department of Clinical Psychology, NIMHANS. The full-day training, held from 9:00 AM to 4:30 PM, combined theoretical insights with practical strategies to support students' emotional well-being.

An introduction to mental health was given at the start of the meeting, emphasizing the value of early intervention. In addition to outlining important warning

indicators including behavioural changes, academic degradation, and social withdrawal, the resource persons talked about common psychological issues like stress, worry, and depression. Gate Keepers were taught to treat students with compassion and offer the right kind of assistance.

Interactive activities like role-play and brainstorming sessions allowed educators to practice real-life scenarios, boosting their confidence in handling sensitive situations. Open discussions encouraged participants to share their experiences and clarify doubts, fostering a collaborative learning atmosphere. The session reinforced the vital role educators play in supporting student's mental health and highlighted the need for continued focus on mental health education.

The session aimed to enhance educators' understanding of Bloom's Taxonomy, which classifies learning objectives into six levels: Remembering, Understanding, Applying, Analysing, Evaluating, and Creating. Prof. Naveen highlighted

how these levels could improve teaching methods, curriculum design, and student evaluation. He provided practical insights on aligning program objectives with course objectives and demonstrated how to integrate Bloom's Taxonomy into question paper design and lesson planning.

Interactive discussions and real-world examples were key features of the session. Faculty actively participated in exercises on mapping course outcomes (CO) with program outcomes (PO). A structured feedback mechanism allowed participants to share their insights and learning experiences, fostering a collaborative atmosphere.

The session concluded with positive feedback from participants, who acknowledged the value of Bloom's Taxonomy in enhancing academic standards and improving teaching strategies.

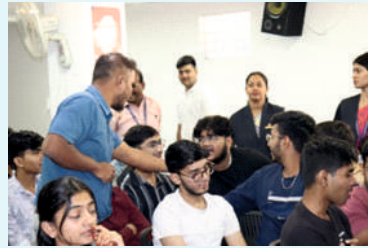

Industrial Visit to CRG Coffee & Spices



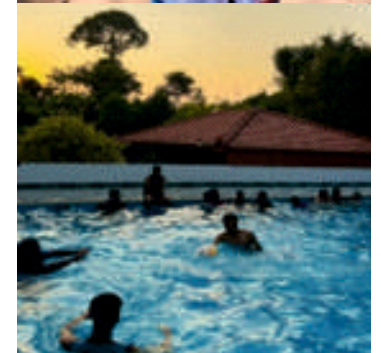

NAVIGATING THE FUTURE Career Guidance Session for PUC Students

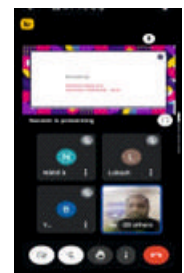

“Edchemy Staff Training Session”



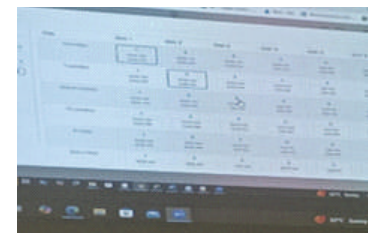

A Moment of Mindfulness: Meditation Day at the campus



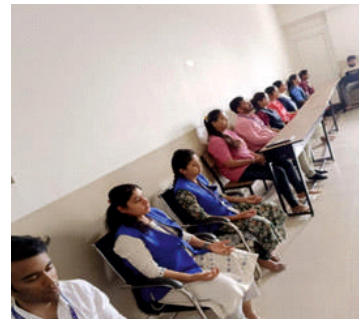

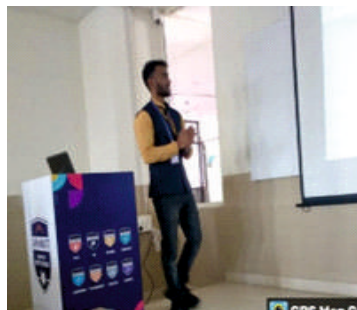
The program featured an inspiring speech by Principal Dr. S. Anil Kumar on Gandhiji's contributions,

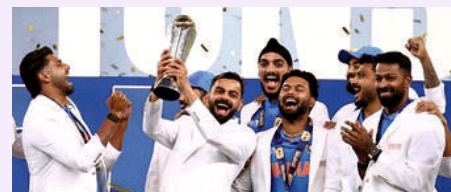


Indian Sports: Triumphs, Talent, and Honors
