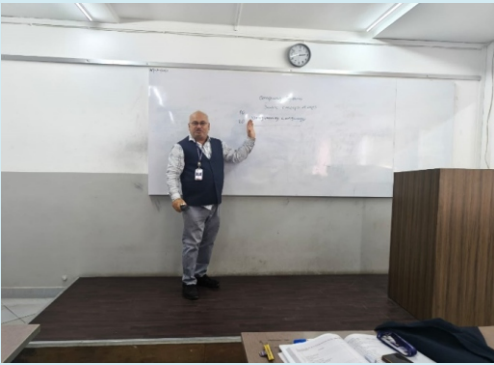

18th June, Mrs. Khyati Joshi, an expert in the field of Digital Marketing, addressed the

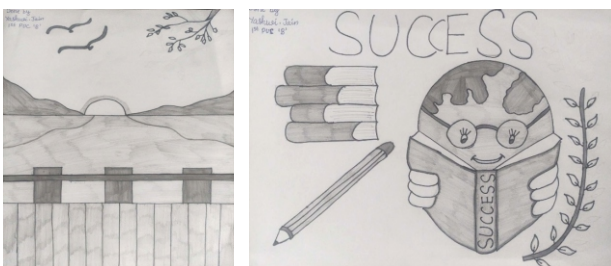
students. She spoke about the rise of digital platforms, content marketing, and social media strategies. Her session was interactive and thought-provoking.

Empowering Young Voters: Voter Day 2025

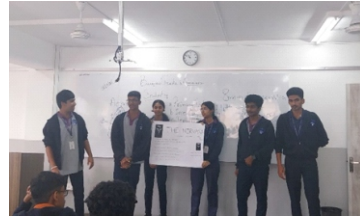

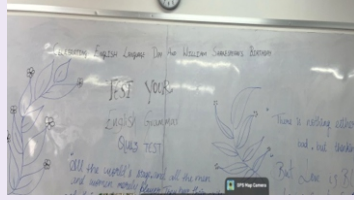


A Literary Tribute to Language and Legacy

11 PUC students narrated environmental stories, while a Sanskrit faculty sang a meaningful song about trees. A quiz on environmental topics saw

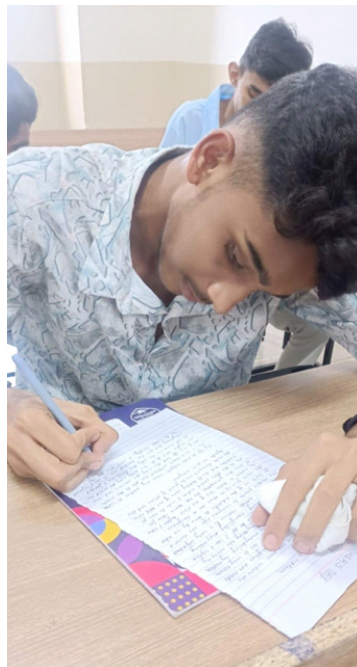
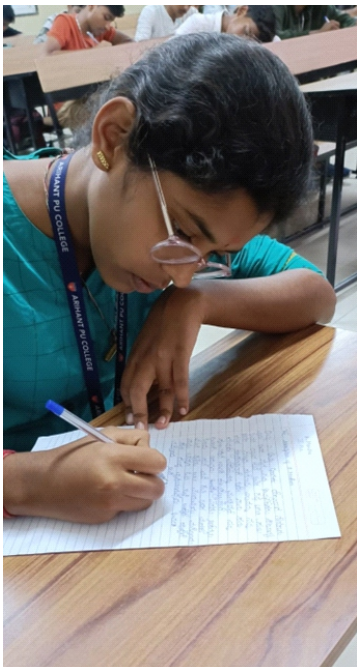
enthusiastic student participation, with small gifts awarded for correct answers. A sapling was gifted to the Eco Club, reinforcing the message of conservation.

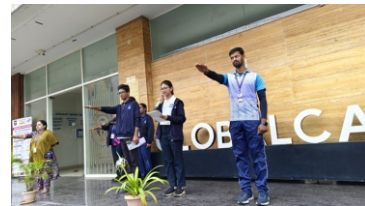
Observance of the Preamble Reading

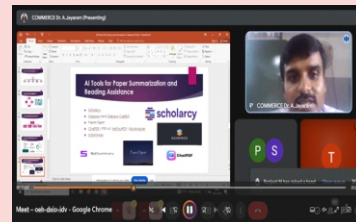
Following this, Mr. Kumar delivered an engaging session on technical tools and banking awareness. The

Empowering Research with AI: A National FDP Recap



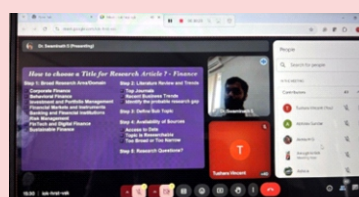
